What we believe about:

The Bible

- It is the divinely “inspired” Word of God.
- It is our guide and authority for all matters of faith and action.
- All should study it, on their own, in order for each to develop a personal faith.
- (2 Timothy 3.16; 2 Peter 1.20,21; 1 John 4.1)

God

- There is one true and living God who exists in three eternal and equal persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- God intentionally and intelligently created the world and everything in it.
- (Matthew 28.19; John 14.16-26; Genesis 1-2)

Jesus

- God’s only Son, the Savior of the world, and Lord of all.
- He was born of a virgin, led a sinless life, died for our sins, rose from the dead, ascended to heaven, and is coming back.
- He lived a perfect life and set the standard for his followers to imitate.
- He is the only way we can be right with God.
- (John 3.16; 1 Corinthians 15.3-5; Philippians 2.5-8; Hebrews 4.14-15; 1 Peter 2.21-24; John 14.6)

Mankind

- Created by God and made in his image, giving all people value, dignity, and purpose.
- Every person has willfully sinned, becoming separated from God, lost, without hope, and in need of a Savior.
- (Psalm 139; Luke 18.9-14; Matthew 18.3-7; Romans 3.23)

Salvation

- We believe that death seals the eternal destiny of each person. The saved will be assigned eternal life; the unsaved will suffer eternal separation from God.
- Because of love, God sent Jesus into the world to die, in order to provide a way for every person to “come back” to God.
- Salvation comes by grace through faith...a gift from God that we cannot earn and do not deserve.
- The right response to grace includes: repentance (turning around), publicly confessing a belief that Jesus is who he claims to be, baptism (a public demonstration of trust in and allegiance to Jesus), and a continued obedience to his commands.
- (Isaiah 53.1-6; Romans 5.8; Matthew 28.18-20; Acts 2.38; Romans 6.1-7; Ephesians 2.8-10)

The Holy Spirit

- The Holy Spirit is the presence of Jesus Christ, living inside the lives of his followers.
- Every Christian is a new creation and is given the Holy Spirit to guide, to comfort, to transform, and to empower us to become like Christ in attitude, purpose, and action.
- (2 Corinthians 5.17; John 14.26; Romans 8.9, 26-27; Acts 2.38)

The Church

- Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church, his Body.
- As the Body of Christ, the Church is the extension of Jesus' character, attitude, behavior, and mission to the world today.
- Jesus Christ came to rescue broken and lost people and has called his Church to complete the task.
- The Church exists to equip people to accomplish the task.
- We understand that every believer is to be an ambassador and a minister.
- We believe that God calls the Body of Christ to be his ambassadors on earth, living as one people regardless of nationality, race, or economic standing.
